



THE ELIZABETH HOGAN FRANZHEIM SCHOLARSHIP

Background:

Elizabeth Hogan Franzheim was born in Wheeling, WV, on July 8, 1923 and spent her life in our community. She was a graduate of Mt. DeChantal Visitation Academy in Wheeling and a graduate of West Virginia University. She was a devoted member of St. Michael Parish and was dedicated to her family and the city of Wheeling.

Her sons, L. Woodward Franzheim III, William Hogan Franzheim and Jeffrey Renner Franzheim received their elementary educations at St. Michael Parish School.

“Betty” passed away on October 16, 2010. She kindly left a portion of her estate to qualified educational organizations to provide scholarships to eligible students.



Eligibility:

Beginning in 2012, the *Elizabeth Hogan Franzheim Scholarship Fund* has awarded one year scholarships to students based on financial need. The selection committee will endeavor to select students who would not be able to attend St. Michael Parish School without financial assistance. Preference will be given to students entering the school in the lower grades although all applicants will be considered. The recipients must reside in Wheeling, WV or the immediate surrounding area. Families may re-apply for the *Elizabeth Hogan Franzheim Scholarship* each year.

A selection committee will review applications each summer. Scholarships will be awarded and applied to the tuition balance for the upcoming school year after applying all other financial assistance received.
