



The CMCW Scholarship in honor of the confraternity's patron saint Our of Lady of Sorrows

Background:

The Confraternity of Christian Mothers and Christian Women of St. Michael Parish was established on November 21, 1900. The purpose of the CMCW is to help like minded Catholic Mothers (spiritual and physical moms) and women come together through prayer, sharing, Scripture, and reception of the Sacraments. We believe that through Christ and the powerful intercession and protection of the Blessed Virgin Mary, we are supported and strengthened in raising our children, and helped to recognize and stand firm against the godless influences that undermine and oppose God's work in the souls of our children.

Returning students in grades 5-8 are eligible to apply for this scholarship funded by our confraternity. There will be one recipient of a non-renewable \$500 scholarship.

Criteria:

- Must be active in giving of your time and talent to parish, school and community
- Completed 2-3 paragraph essay on how we can remain true to God's word and live our lives as faithful Catholics in a world where godless influences undermine Christ and his church.
